During the Fall Semester, 2021, STARBASE WPAFB sponsored an after school program known as Starbase 2.0. After recruiting a couple of mentors, which is no easy task during a pandemic, and getting students to sign up for the program, they were able to then meet as a group on Tuesday evenings throughout Oct.-Dec. at Coy Middle School in Beavercreek, OH. The mentors and students were able to work on goal setting, life skills, and team building as well as some STEM projects. Students were given three main projects to focus on: electric circuitry, sound/vibration, and robotics. Not everything went as planned, but the problems allowed for learning moments on how to adapt and manage time.

The Spring Semester, 2022, will see STARBASE 2.0 back in action. However, as with all things dealing with COVID-19, plans are delayed due to issues with mentors. It is expected that the program will be up and running in March. This will hopefully allow for the peak of the latest COVID surge to pass. Starting in March, the mentors will be meeting with students at Ankeney Middle School in Beavercreek, OH. Starbase 2.0 is a great program for mentoring students in the community. Do you have a couple of hours that you could donate to help us out. We meet about two times a month in the early evening to work with our student participants. At this point in time, we are scheduled to meet on Tuesday evenings. There is no required skill set or knowledge base needed, just a willingness to roll up your sleeves and work with students in the 6th grade as they problem solve and discuss life skills/ goals. 
