While exploring the real-world theme, teams use basic engineering concepts to build a model made of LEGO elements. They also learn to present information through a Show-Me Poster. Throughout the experience, teams operate under the FIRST Core Values; celebrating discovery, teamwork, and Gracious Professionalism®.

In this #SUPERPOWERED season, FIRST LEGO League Explore teams will learn where energy comes from and how it is distributed, stored, and used. They will solve real-world problems related to energy usage and help realize a brighter future through innovative ideas in energy generation, efficiency, and use. Teams will be able to showcase learning at the end of the season by attending a festival. In the Dayton area, teams can participate in a festival held at the FLL and FTC State Championship at Hobart Arena in March! We can't wait to see what they accomplish!
